# The Drug Related Intimidation Initiative (DRII)



**DRUG-RELATED INTIMIDATION (DRI)** is a common and persistent issue which is damaging to individuals, families and communities. It can take many different forms, such as:

- Direct violence or threats of violence to people who use drugs, or their families and loved ones, arising from non-payment of drug debts
- Demands to carry out illegal activities such as holding or moving drugs
- Less direct activities related to drug markets which can contribute to a community-wide perception of intimidation

It can often be difficult for people affected by DRI to know what supports are available and how to access them. The DRII is a free, confidential service that can help people affected by intimidation understand what their options are. If you're affected by DRI, you can call us on 085-8588988.

## What can we do for you?



- **WE'LL LISTEN TO YOU.** We understand that DRI greatly affects the lives of those who experience it, and that you know best what might be of help to you.
- **WE'LL BE DISCREET.** We don't need to record any personal details. We can speak on the phone, meet you in a public place or in a community service where you feel comfortable.
- **WE'LL BE FLEXIBLE.** Our hours are generally Monday to Friday, 9.30am to 5.30pm but we can meet outside these times if it works better for you.
- **WE'LL HELP YOU UNDERSTAND YOUR OPTIONS.** We can tell you what services are available in the local area that could help. We know how these services work and can give you the information you need to access them.
